

## GARDEN SPOT VILLAGE ANNOUNCES 2011-2012 SATURDAY EVENING CONCERT SERIES

*Pianist James Correnti will perform Nov. 19*

**NEW HOLLAND, Pa. — Oct. 25, 2011** — Garden Spot Village announces the line-up for its 2011-2012 Saturday Evening Concert Series, a program of free performances for residents and the general public.

“We welcome our neighbors to join us for some exceptional entertainment,” said Colleen Musselman, director of life enrichment at the retirement community. “The series includes a wide range of vocal and instrumental performances in several musical genres.”

The season begins with a performance by pianist James Correnti on Sat., Nov. 19. Correnti began studying piano at age 7 and eventually earned a degree in music from New York City’s Julliard School. He has released two compact discs and given more than 4,000 performances. A former pastor of Fleishman Memorial Baptist Church in Philadelphia, Rev. Correnti is chairman of keyboard studies at Eastern University and affiliate artist at the Philadelphia Biblical University School of Music and Performing Arts.

Other concerts in the series at Garden Spot Village include the Garden Spot High School Vocal Ensemble on Dec. 17; the Four Piece Quartet on Jan. 21; Red Rose City Chorus on Feb. 18; and the Schwandt Family Chamber Ensemble on Mar. 17. The Heritage Chorale of Lancaster will wrap up the season with a performance on Apr. 21.

All concerts begin at 7 p.m. in the chapel at Garden Spot Village, 433 S. Kinzer Ave. The concerts are free and open to the public. Donations to the Garden Spot Village Benevolent Fund, which helps support residents who need financial assistance, will be accepted at the door.
