

GARDEN SPOT VILLAGE TO BRING DRIVE-IN MOVIES TO NEW HOLLAND

Community hosts free family-oriented entertainment under the stars

NEW HOLLAND, Pa. — Mar. 22, 2011 — This summer, area families can enjoy movie stars under the nighttime stars at Garden Spot Village. In conjunction with the USA Theatre Company, the retirement community will host three drive-in movie screenings on its campus at 433 S. Kinzer Ave.

“We are excited about this opportunity to enjoy some good old-fashioned fun with our neighbors from throughout the surrounding community,” said Colleen Musselman, director of life enrichment at Garden Spot Village.

Movies will run on a 40-foot-high screen sponsored by Turkey Hill. Moviegoers are welcome to stay in their cars and tune in to the soundtrack via their car radio or bring blankets and lawn chairs and listen to the outdoor sound system.

“We have more than 2 acres of lawn seating, but parking will be limited to 80 cars,” Musselman said.

Dates for the drive-in movie nights are Jun. 24, Jul. 22 and Aug. 26. Titles will be announced.

“We will be showing family-friendly movies,” Musselman said. “As we get close to each movie night, we’ll have a chance to select from more recent titles.”

Concession stands will offer popcorn, candy, beverages and more for purchase. Concessions open at 7 p.m., and the movie begins at dusk. There is no charge for admission. Donations to the Garden Spot Village Benevolent Fund will be accepted at the gate.
